Academy District 20 will utilize, to the extent economically and practically feasible, sustainability principles to achieve healthy, productive, fiscally responsible, and safe environments for students, staff, parents, and the community. The District will seek to preserve natural resources while balancing social, economic, and environmental issues. Using sustainability as a framework for decision-making and operational principles, Academy District 20 will:

- implement sustainability objectives and goals;
- foster student participation in sustainability initiatives to strengthen commitment to develop responsible, prepared, and productive members of society;
- recognize outstanding sustainability-related performance in the District;
- commit to the responsible stewardship of both natural and economic resources, including recycling;
- provide sustainability program oversight through the District 20 Green Team;
- reduce energy consumption District-wide; and
- manage a five-year energy related capital project portfolio.
