



Title: **BSR 3.1 -- Unity of Control**

Code: 3.1

Section: 3. BSRs -- Board-Superintendent Relationship

Only official decisions of the Board of Education acting as an entity are binding on the Superintendent.

Accordingly,

1. Decisions or instructions of individual Board members, officers and committees are not binding on the Superintendent except in rare instances when the Board of Education has specifically delegated such exercise of authority.
2. In the case of Board members or committees requesting information or assistance which, in the Superintendent's opinion, requires a material amount of staff time or that is unreasonable or disruptive, the Superintendent may refuse such requests. The committee or the member may subsequently refer such requests to the full Board of Education for consideration.
