



Title: **Senior Citizen Tax Work-Off Program procedure**

Code: DEAB R

Section: Section D: Fiscal

The following guidelines shall be followed to implement the senior citizen tax work-off program:

1. Applicants must be over the age of 60.
2. Applicants must own and live in the home for which they are applying for the tax work-off program to help pay the District's share of the taxes thereon.
3. Each household will be allowed to work toward a maximum credit equal to the amount of property taxes collected for the benefit of Academy School District 20, or portion thereof up to \$800, whichever amount is lesser, at federal minimum wage.
4. Applications are available through the Human Resources department.
5. Applications will be approved on a first-come, first-served basis.
