



Title: **Student Transportation in Rented/District Vehicles**

Code: EEA E

Section: Section E: Support Services

The school district's transportation program is primarily designed to transport students to school and back in an efficient, safe, and economical manner. There are additional considerations regarding the safe transport of students to athletic events and other extracurricular activities by school staff members in District vehicles, rented vehicles or by charter bus companies.

In order to assure the most appropriate and safe travel for students involved in these types of activities, District staff members will adhere to the following:

- District schools/departments shall not operate vehicles with a capacity greater than 15 occupants (including the vehicle operator) for the transport of District staff members or students. Larger capacity transportation shall be coordinated through Transportation (see below).
- District staff members who transport students to activities must first obtain appropriate activity bus driver training from the District's Transportation Department.
- Prior to arranging external transportation service, all staff members will coordinate with the Transportation Department to obtain pre-approval for the use of rental vehicles or charter bus service.
