



Title: **EL 2.1 -- Treatment of Students**

Code: 2.01

Section: 2. ELs -- Executive Limitations

With respect to student interactions or conditions, the Superintendent will not cause or allow conditions or procedures that are unclear, unfair, unsafe, untimely, undignified, unresponsive, or unnecessarily intrusive.

Accordingly, the Superintendent will not:

1. Collect, review, transmit, store or destroy student information in a manner that fails to protect against improper access to that information.
2. Permit the administration of corporal punishment.
3. Redesign attendance boundaries for students without the knowledge and consent of the Board.
4. Allow students to be unprepared to deal with unsafe conditions or emergency situations.
5. Allow students to be unprepared or uninformed about disciplinary policies, district requirements, including graduation requirements, and college entrance requirements.
6. Permit improper student access to and utilization of electronically distributed information.
7. Fail to celebrate student accomplishments or allow them to be ignored or unreported.
8. Operate without communicating to students and their parents a clear understanding of what may be expected from district services offered.
9. Operate without informing students of this policy, and without providing a complaint response process to students who believe they have not been accorded a reasonable interpretation of their protections under this policy.
10. Fail to consider student input in district decision making, as appropriate.
